Hello Tim,

I want to share with you how much SC Hunters for the Hungry means to us here at Feed A Hungry Child Pickens County. We currently serve over 700 students in our Pickens County schools who are in need of food for the weekend when they go home from school. We also donate snacks to all the school nurses in Pickens County to give out during the week to children in need. There are 24 schools in Pickens County currently plus a Career and Technology Center.

Last year I was handed a brochure for SC Hunters for the Hungry. I read where they were donating food to help families in need. I reached out to Tim Sorrells, and he gave us hundreds of packs of venison sticks. We took these to our school nurses, and I cannot describe the incredible response from these ladies as they shared how the students loved the venison sticks. It was not only a great snack, but a better source of protein that many of these children were not getting. What a blessing!

Here in Pickens County, we are at 64% poverty rate in our schools with some schools close to 80% individually. This food is vital to these students who would otherwise have nothing to eat on the weekend. SC Hunters for the Hungry help us here at Feed A Hungry Child to make the snacks we deliver to our schools do more for the health of these wonderful students. For many of them their grades improve, their attendance improves, and they are encouraged that they are cared for by people who do not know them by name.
